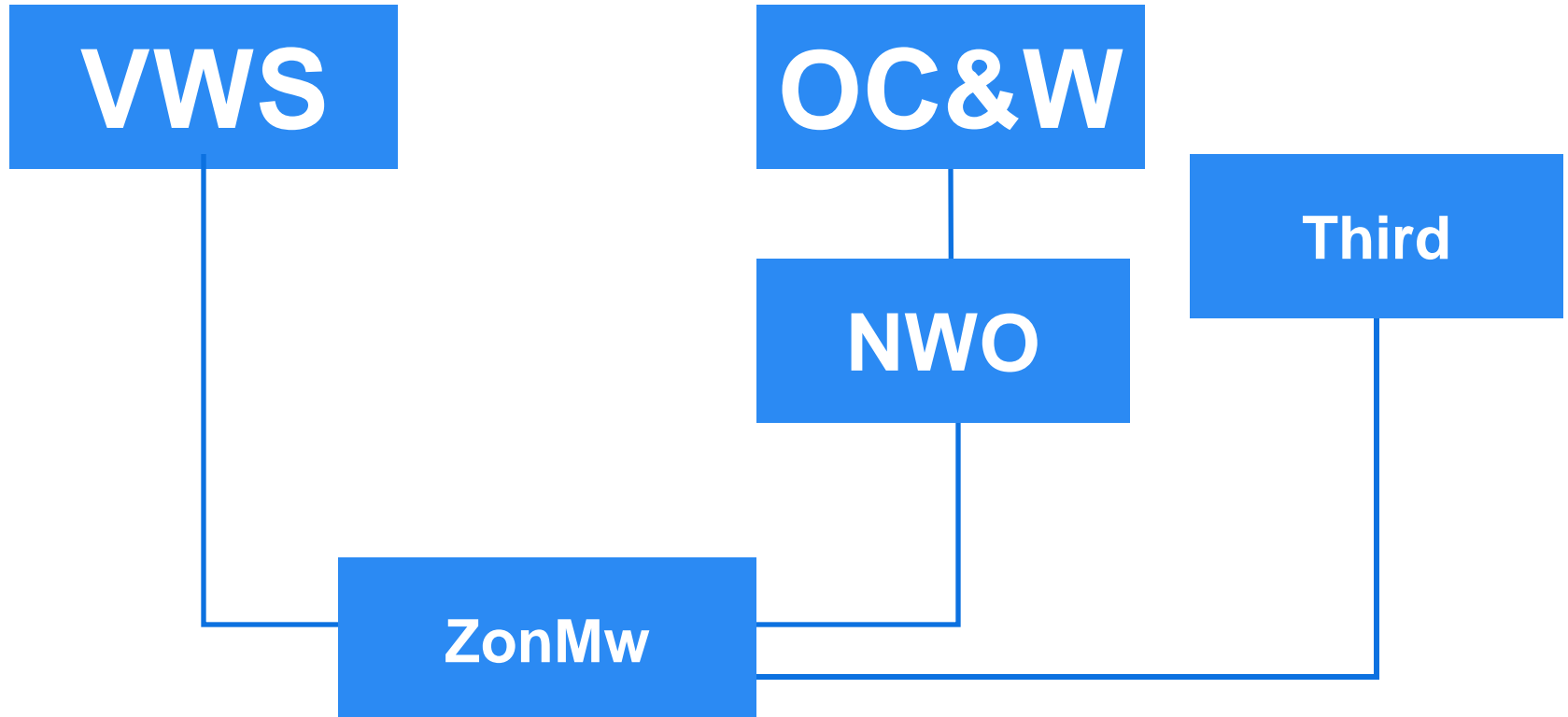
Mission: ZonMw stimulates health research and health care innovation

Innovation = knowledge x implementation

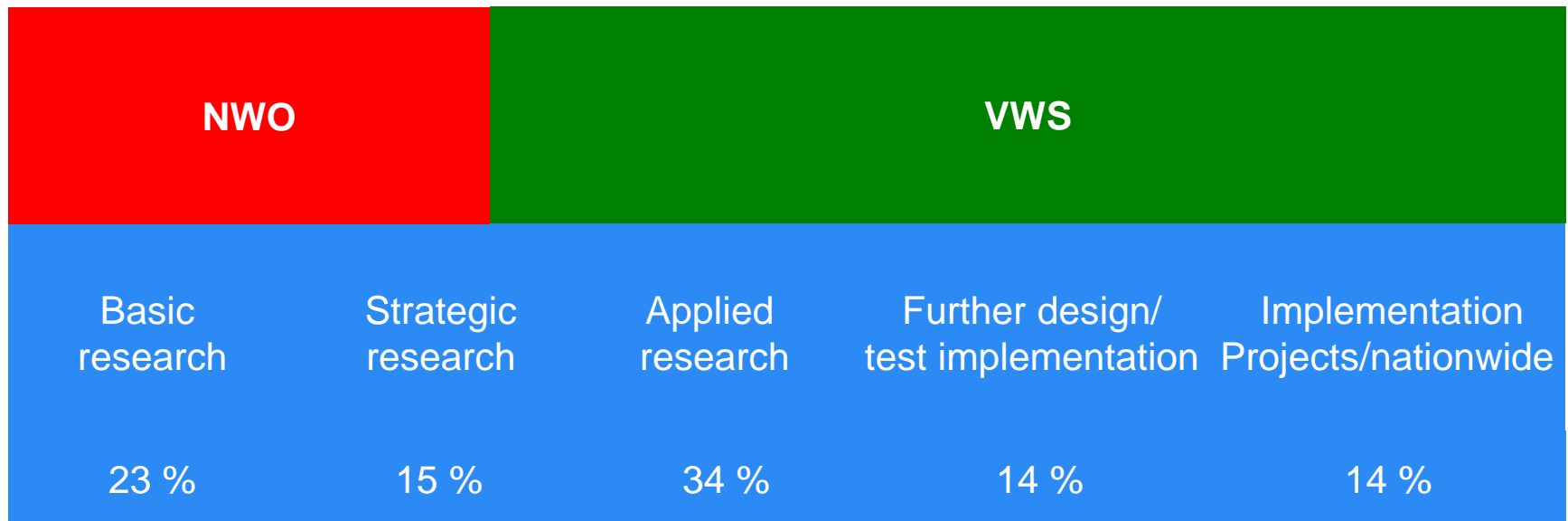
Innovation through services, technology and products

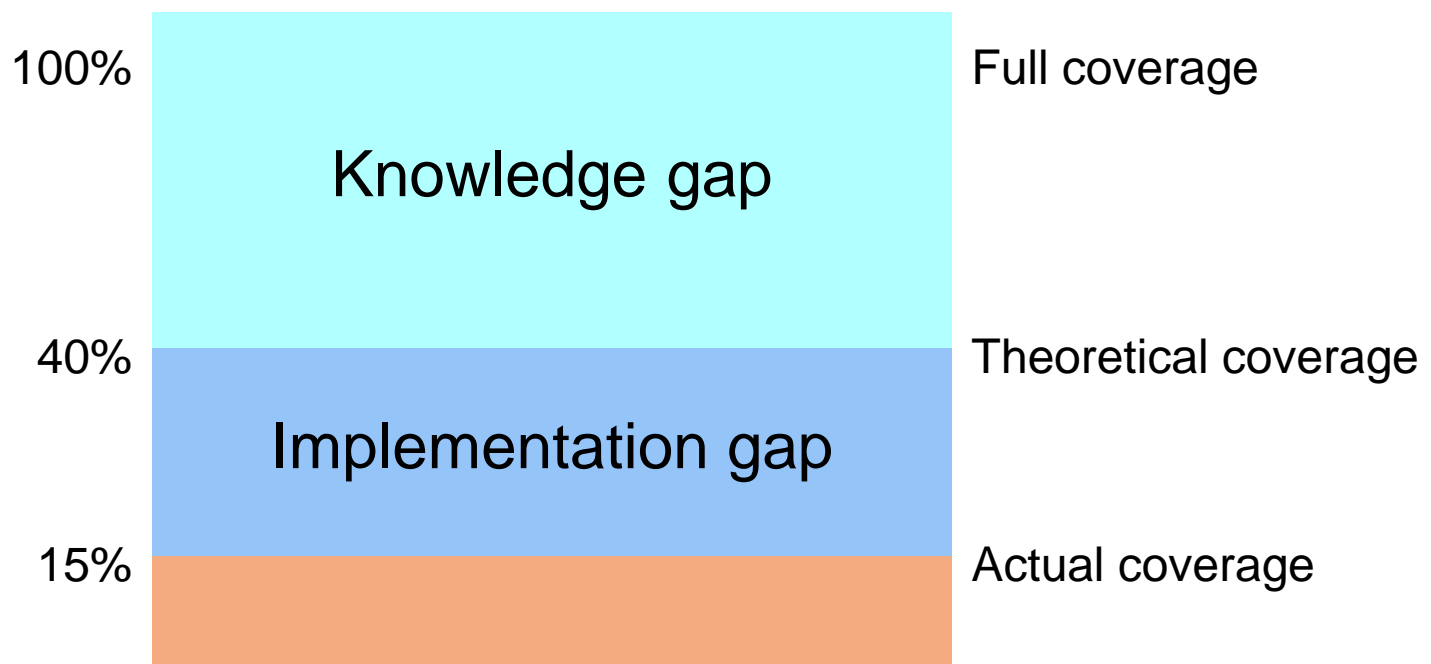


ZonMw knowledge chain

The working mode of ZonMw

- Commission (VWS, NWO, others)
- Translation into a Programme
- Broad programme committee
- Calls for proposals, peer review
- Granting of projects
- Monitoring, knowledge transfer and implementation



What is a granting programme

- Health problem, research question
- Background and context
- Aim and target groups
- Main priorities
- Specific conditions
- Budget: total and max per project
- Timetable and assessment procedure

Two stage Procedure

1. Project Idea
2. Assessment Project Idea on relevance
3. Invitation to submit full proposals – denial through advice not to submit
4. Peer review + rebuttal
5. Quality, relevance, ranking
6. (Conditional) Granting, or denial

Focus on nursing in a number of programmes

Specially for nursing:

- Strengthening the research infrastructure for nursing research
- Improving the quality of nursing and care
 - Development of guidelines
 - Education

- Care for the elderly
- Palliative care
- Youth
