National Care for the elderly program

- Aim: better <u>quality of life</u> for <u>frail elderly persons</u> through better quality of care, tailored to their needs
- 2008-2016 on behalf of the Ministry of Health, Welfare and Sport, directed by ZonMw (The Netherlands Organisation for Health Research and Development), budget >€87M








National Care for the elderly program

Three steps

- Formation of regional networks based on common vision of the desired results
- 2. Innovative experiments and projects
- Nationwide dissemination and implementation (Platform BeterOud)
- University Medical Centres
- GP's
- hospitals, care and nursing homes
- informal care organisations
- health insurers, municipalities
- elderly (associations)



Key elements

- Elderly participation, to ensure that what is being developed really suits there requirements
- Working together in networks, including different financial and professional domains
- Connecting research, policy and practise.
- Ongoing innovation-cycle







Elderly participation

- Participation of elderly takes place in thee different levels:
 - National
 - Regional networks
 - Projects
 - In education
- ZonMw set stringent criteria on participation of elderly in these levels. But does not determine how to organise it.

How to get elder patients in the lead?

- Discussion in focus groups (caregivers)
- The ZWIP idea is tested by a jury of elderly people (panel)
- Test panel of the ZWIP application
- Digital panel of patients and caregivers users
- All users of the VIP app (Calculus / Topicus)







ZWIP (Health and Welfare Information Portal)

Personal "digital conference table"

Principles: online social networks (e.g. FaceBook)

Older person chairs his own ZWIP care network

-Invitations and keep network up-to-date

ZWIP offers:

- -Possibility to communicate easily
- -Acces to shared patient information











ZWIP creates a virtual "conference table"

Using the internet/SoMe principles **patient**, caregivers and healthcare professionals can a personalized care network for information exchange communication, consultation and

collaboration


















National Care for the Elderly Program
