What is a granting programme

- Health problem, research question
- Background and context
- Aim and target groups
- Main priorities
- Specific conditions
- Budget: total and max per project
- Timetable and assessment procedure



Two stage Procedure

- 1. Project Idea
- 2. Assessment ProjectIdea on relevance
- 3. Invitation to submit full proposals denial through advice not to submit
- 4. Peer review + rebuttal
- 5. Quality, relevance, ranking
- 6. (Conditional) Granting, or denial



Focus on nursing in a number of programmes Specially for nursing:
